


OPERATOR'S MANUAL DADO THROAT PLATE

A31TS01 (FOR USE WITH THE BTS10, BTS11 TABLE SAWS)

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INTRODUCTION

This tool has many features for making its use more pleasant and enjoyable. Safety, performance, and dependability have been given top priority in the design of this product making it easy to maintain and operate.

GENERAL SAFETY RULES

Safe operation of this accessory requires that you read and understand this operator's manual, the operator's manual for the table saw and all labels affixed to the tool.

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS

- KNOW YOUR ACCESSORY. Read the operator's manual carefully. Learn the product's applications and limitations as well as the specific potential hazards related to this product.
- **KEEP THE WORK AREA CLEAN.** Cluttered work areas and work benches invite accidents. **DO NOT** leave tools or pieces of wood on the saw while operating.
- ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES WITH SIDE SHIELDS. Everyday eyeglasses have only impact-resistant lenses; they are NOT safety glasses.

- DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT WITH OTHER EQUIP-MENT or for other purposes.
- ALWAYS DISCONNECT THE SAW FROM THE POWER SUPPLY BEFORE ASSEMBLING THIS KIT. Make sure the switch is off when reconnecting the saw to a power supply.
- BEFORE MAKING A CUT, BE SURE ALL ADJUST-MENTS ARE SECURE.
- **SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS.** Refer to them frequently and use them to instruct other users. If you loan someone this product, also loan these instructions.

SYMBOLS

The following signal words and meanings are intended to explain the levels of risk associated with this product.			
SYMBOL	SIGNAL	MEANING

UNPACKING


TOOLS NEEDED

WARNING:

If any parts are missing, replace the missing parts before assembling the kit. Failure to do so could result in serious personal injury.



ASSEMBLY

INSTALLING A DADO INSERT

See Figures 1-2.

■ Unplug the saw.




WARNING:

Do not allow familiarity with tools to make you careless. Remember that a careless fraction of a second is sufficient to inflict severe injury.



WARNING:

Failure to turn the saw off, remove the switch key, and unplug the saw could result in accidental starting causing possible serious personal injury.



ASSEMBLY

- Lower the blade below the table surface.
- Loosen the screws and remove the throat plate.
- Remove the blade and blade guard assembly following instructions in the table saw Operator's Manual.
- Included with the dado set are installation instructions. Follow these instructions to install the dado set.

NOTE: When using 3/8 in. width dado set use outer flange and nut.


NOTE: When using 7/16 in. width dado set use nut only.

- Place dado insert on the table saw as shown in figure 1.
- Securely tighten using screws provided.



WARNING:

Never stand directly in line with the blade or allow hands to come closer than 3 in. to the blade. Do not reach over or across the blade. Failure to heed this warning can result in serious personal injury.



OPERATION

APPLICATIONS

You may use this tool for the purposes listed below:

■ For cutting up to 7/16 in. maximum width dadoes on BTS10 and BTS11 Ryobi table saws.



WARNING:

Never install a dado set to cut a larger groove than 7/16 in. in width. Installing a wider dado set could result in insufficient thread engagement of the arbor nut. Never use any blade or dado set with less than full engagement of the nut of the threaded arbor shaft. Insufficient thread engagement could result in the blade or dado loosening on the arbor shaft and could result in serious personal injury.

USING A DADO INSERT

■ Make sure the wood is not touching the blade. Plug in the saw, insert the switch key, and turn the saw on. Let the saw build up to full speed before feeding the workpiece into the blade. Always use push sticks or push blocks with dado cuts.



WARNING:

Always use push sticks or push blocks when making non-through cuts to avoid the risk of serious injury. Never feed wood with your hands.

- Follow all dado instructions.
- When the work is complete, turn the saw off, remove the switch key, and unplug the saw.
- Lower the blade below the table surface.



▲ WARNING:

Lower the blade to prevent possible injury.

- Remove the dado insert and dado set.
- Reinstall the blade, blade guard assembly, and throat plate following instructions in the Operator's Manual.



WARNING:

To reduce the risk of injury and before plugging the saw back in, make sure the blade guard is installed and working properly.
